



Acorn Card Policy

The Acorn Card is a library card available for two types of people:

- Minors who are 18 years old and younger
- Vulnerable adults*

The Acorn Card limits use to two items total at a time in the appropriate category for the holder. Once the two items are returned the Acorn Card User may borrow two more items. The Card holder must be present to use this card. Cards will expire every year. Fines will not accrue, and parental permission is not required.

However, if the applicant is under the age of 18 years old and wishes to have computer privileges, then an adult must sign and agree to the Computer User Agreement.

Acorn Card (18 and under)	Acorn Card (Vulnerable Adult*)
May borrow all circulating items except for Laptops, Video Games, DVDs and BluRay Discs	May borrow all circulating items
Limited to two items total for borrower's card	Limited to two items total for borrower's card

*A vulnerable adult is an individual over the age of 18 who is mentally or physically challenged to a degree that significantly impairs ability to provide adequately for his/her own care or manage his/her own behavior without assistance.
